

Instructions to Vendors/Exhibitors at the Grey to Green Festival September 10, 2011

Hello Everyone:

Thank you for your registration with the Grey to Green Festival. We're looking forward to seeing you on Saturday, Sept. 10. 2011.

Here's some basic information:

- Please arrive in plenty of time to be set up and ready to go by 10:00 a.m. The tents will be set up early in the morning on the day of the festival. If it takes them longer than usual we ask for your patience and understanding if there is any delay in your ability to set up.
- Please enter Wick Park from the Park Avenue side and go toward the pavilion. You will see tables near the road for registration. This is where you will be given your assigned area and table number.
- If you are in need of assistance with unloading and setting up a volunteer will be made available to assist you. Please if you are handicapped let one of our volunteers know so we can better assist you.
- We ask that you then drive to your location and unload your materials. Once unloaded please quickly move your vehicle outside the park; we suggest you park on Park Ave. to the western end, near Fifth Ave to allow closer parking for those attending the festival. Elm Street parking will be reserved for those dropping off items at the Drop and Shop and for vehicles delivering animals.
- Tables and chairs will be provided however if your exhibit or vending area requires computer usage, please operate on battery power. The park's only available electrical hookup is in the Pavilion area. Please keep in mind that our goal is to use as little energy as possible.
- We also ask that you avoid using plastic bags when possible. Please leave your location as clean as it was when you arrived. If possible we ask that you bring a bag for trash so that you can take it with you when you leave.
- We will provide programs with the list of activities, vendors, and events, and attendees will be encouraged to recycle them if they choose not to keep them.
- **There will be food vendors at the Farmers Market** across Elm Street in the area of the Unitarian Church from 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM. Please note that all utensils being used at the church are compostable, as are napkins and cups. There will be a composter available specifically for this purpose.
- You will be given a list of names and cell phone numbers of contact people at the festival. If you run into problems when you arrive, you may call Deb at (330) 207-0994 or Susie at (330) 881-1050 or look for a volunteer wearing a yellow or grey vest.

We have a full day of activities lined up and hope that you have a great time at the Fourth Annual Grey to Green Festival. Thanks to you, we currently have over 50 vendors and exhibitors in addition to the Farmers Market, the Drop and Shop, workshops and children's activities. Please encourage your friends and family to attend!
